

Set the Chromebook to a different language


1. Open the settings menu by clicking on the gear icon in the Chromebook menu




2. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click "Show advanced settings..."




3. Click the button for “Language and input settings...”




4. In the window that comes up if the language you want is not in the list click the “Add” button.



5. Select the language you want and click “Display Google Chrome OS in this language”




6. Click the “Sign out” button.




Once you sign back in to the Chromebook it will be in the new language.

Set the Chromebook back to English


1. Click the blue bar to bring up the Chromebook menu. Click the gear icon to bring up the settings window




2. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click the link circled below



3. Scroll down until you see a button that looks like the one circled below. The language may be different but the format of the lines of text and buttons will look the same.



4. Select English as the language you would like to use. There may be a few choices just go down the list until the word English appears. (See the blue circle.) Click the button circled in red on the right side of the image below to set the language to English.



- Click the button circled below to log out of the Chromebook and set the language back to English.
