# History of Colchester EEE and Preschool


Self contained Special Education Program

Regular Education Teacher with limited number of “peers”

Act 166

2 Regular Education Teachers move to Preschool model

2 ½ Regular Teachers, PreQualified Program

# Enrollment Process

## CURRENT STUDENTS

(WHO ARE NOT GOING TO KINDERGARTEN)

- Have first option to return
- Sign a letter of intent to return
- Guaranteed a position

## NEW STUDENTS REQUIREMENTS

- 3 yrs old before September 1st
- Attend Information Session in March
- Complete screening questionnaires

## ALL STUDENTS

- ★ Administration places students in classes
- ★ A waitlist is formed if more than 75 children have expressed an interest in program

# Act 166 Partnerships

184 students in 50 partnering centers



Provide 10 hours of preschool per week



Students must be 3 years old by September 1st



Centers must be qualified through the State



Classes are taught by licensed teacher



Families receive tuition funding up to \$3,178 per child

*(2018-19 tuition funding has increased to \$3,267)*

## Intent of law:

To increase the access to and quality of child care to children in Vermont

## Community Courses

- Social emotional development
- Sensory \ regulation

## Collaboration

- Shared in-service support
- Site visits
- Director to director support

## Consultation

- Crisis support (phone/in person)
- Behavioral supports and planning
- Modeling instructional and behavioral strategies
