

Central Office



- → Built: 1989
- → 31 years old
- → Administrative Offices
- → 16 employees
- → Major Renovations: None
- → Could be expanded to house CSD alternative programs





Colchester High School

- → Built: 1974
- → 46 years old
- → Grades 9-12
- → Current Enrollment: 639
- → Major Renovations:
 Science 2014, PAC 2016,
 Serving Line 2019





CHS Facilities Status and Needs

- Boilers, Roof, Septic are all aging but remain functional with no immediate plans to replace
- Bathroom/Locker Room Renovation
- Complete lighting in PAC
- 1st Floor Learning Annex (AKA the library)
- Athletic Facilities (what does this mean)



Colchester Alternative Program

- → Rental Property
- → \$65K annually
- → Grades 9-12

The second floor of this building is the home for CAP.



CAP Facilities Status and Needs

- Goal is to have a permanent home for CAP
- Grade B Rental Property
- Appraised in 2010 for \$750K, asking Price \$925K
- Challenge: 2nd Floor, 1st floor tenants
- Board Exploration
 - Move CO into EEC, CAP goes into CO
 - Expand CO to include CAP

Colchester Middle School

- → Built: 1968
- → 52 years old

- → Grades 6-8
- → Current Enrollment: 507

→ Major Renovations: None



CMS Facilities Status and Needs

- CMS Food Service area upgraded in 2008
- One section of the roof still needs to be replaced
- Bathrooms and locker room
- Space is a significant issue
 - no room to add any more classrooms
 - Limited space for tuition students
 - Meeting as an entire school is a challenge
 - Gym needs bleachers

Malletts Bay School

- → Built: 1962
- \rightarrow 58 years old
- → Preschool (ages 3-5), 75 students
- → Grades 3-5, 458 students

➔ Major Renovations: 1999







MBS Facilities Status and Needs

- Goal is to remove preschool from this building
 - Drop off/pick up for preschool is less than ideal
 - Increases the number of transitions for students
- Space at MBS is a challenge, large class sizes



Porters Point School



- → Built: 1956
- → 64 years old
- → Grades K 2
- → Current Enrollment: 253
- → Major Renovations: 1980, 1989, 2000



PPS Facilities Status and Needs

- One of the oldest buildings in the district
- Goal is to fully renovate or build a new facility
- Space is an issue
- Large class sizes
- Art and Music share a classroom
- No gymnasium



Union Memorial School



- → Built: 1956
- → 64 years old

- → Grades K 2
- → Current Enrollment: 248
- → Major Renovations:
 1969, 1988, 1989, 2000
