

The primary factors causing the district's enrollment to stabilize over the next 10 years are an increase in number of "empty nest" households turning over, a relatively high number of existing housing units being put on the market and the smaller size of graduating 12th grade classes.



Changes in year-to-year enrollment over the next eight years will primarily be due to constantly sized cohorts entering and moving through the school system in conjunction with smaller cohorts leaving the system.

The State of Vermont sets standards for recommended class size per grade.


Grades K-3:

CHS Schedule and Enrollment

- 1. Ensure *smaller class size in the Green House* (grades 9 & 10) to ensure students have more opportunities for teacher feedback and personalization.
- 2. All science classrooms must adhere to **VOSHA guidelines** and standards for class size to ensure safety for students in a laboratory environment.
- 3. The Vermont School Quality Standards states that at the secondary level the class size should average **24 students or less** and the total class roll of a teacher shall not exceed 100 students.


CHS 2020-2021 Schedule and Enrollment

CHS built this year's schedule (20-21) to reduce class sizes in as many classes as possible. This allows for in-person instruction in both hybrid and full in-person models and permits us to meet physical distancing requirements for COVID.

This resulted in eliminating some elective classes (e.g. Arabic) to free up FTE (teachers) to open more sections of class.

For example, in a normal year the average class size in Earth Systems Science or Biology is approximately 20-24 students. This year the average science class is classes 16-20 students.

Current CHS Enrollment 20-21


