






Recovery Plan

The US and VT Agencies of Education recognize that during the COVID pandemic engagement, social-emotional learning and academic achievement have been impacted, and existing equity gaps have increased.

To address these needs Federal funds from the CARES Act are available for the next 3 years to support recovery efforts.


School districts in Vermont are required to develop a Recovery Plan that aims to reduce equity gaps in access, opportunities and outcomes from the pandemic.



Components




