“Shall the voters of the school district approve the school board to expend Forty-Eight Million, Five Hundred Sixty-Three Thousand, Two Hundred Nine Dollars (\$48,563,209), which is the amount the Colchester School Board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year?” It is estimated that the proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$16,445.71 per equalized pupil. **ARTICLE 6 - Town Transportation Captial Plan**

"Shall the Town of Colchester reauthorize the Selectboard to maintain a reserve fund accumulating annually through the continuation of the existing tax rate in the amount of \$0.023 (two and one third cents) per one hundred dollars of assessed property value, for a period of six years, for the purpose of financing the Capital Transportation Plan?"

**ARTICLE 7 - Malletts Bay Sewer Project**

"Shall revenue bonds or notes of the Town of Colchester in the amount of \$11,500,000.00 be issued under Chapter 101 and Subchapter 2 of Chapter 53 of Title 24, Vermont Statutes Annotated, payable only from available grants-in-aid and net revenues derived from the Town's public sewer system over a period not to exceed thirty years, for improvements with a total estimated cost of \$16,700,000.00 to the Town's public sewer system, specifically the construction of a sewer system in the Malletts Bay area?"
