

But It's Just a Cold...

Remember that colds, flu, and COVID all share many similar symptoms. We do not know what virus someone has without a COVID test. Please keep your child home when they are sick. If symptoms continue past 24 hours, a negative COVID test (PCR) will be required before returning to school. Thank you for keeping MBS healthy!







I'm so happy that the COVID vaccine is now available to the MBS agegroup. If your child has received their second vaccine, please let me know. If you are able, please share a copy of their COVID vaccine card with me so I can add this to their vaccination records. Students are considered 'fully vaccinated' 2 weeks after their second dose. It will be helpful for contact tracing purposes if I have this information on file in the event of a COVID case in your child's classroom. 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Preschool

Every preschool family will be receiving a copy of their child's Teaching Strategies Gold Assessment in the mail after December 15th. Teaching Strategies GOLD® (TSG) is the state approved assessment tool used to track the developmental progress of children attending public preschool programs in Vermont. It helps teachers to observe children in the context of everyday experiences, which is an effective way to learn what the children know and can do and collect data in real time. The TSG collects information on Social Emotional, Motor, Cognitive, Literacy, Mathematics, Science and Technology, Social Studies, The Arts, and English Language Acquisition skills. Teaching Strategies GOLD® can be used to assess all children, including English-language learners, children with disabilities, and children who demonstrate competencies beyond typical developmental expectations.
